What you will learn

There was a time when a business was more-or-less fully protected if it was covered by property insurance, general liability insurance, auto insurance, and workers' compensation insurance. Those days have passed, despite the arrival of businessowners insurance (BOP) policies and other package policies that combine property insurance with general liability insurance and some additional coverages. A variety of emerging exposures now require special attention that these traditional policies simply do not adequately address. Cyber exposures present one of the most significant coverage gaps.

Currently, "cyber" can be defined as an adjective meaning of, relating to, or involving computers or computer networks (such as the internet). So when we refer to "cyber exposures" and "cyber insurance," we are broadly referring to the risks associated with computers and computer networks, including the internet.

This course is designed to help insurance agents and brokers prevent E&O claims that result when a client discovers that his or her cyber exposures were not adequately addressed by insurance or other risk management measures.

While the direct premium savings from attending this seminar can be significant for policyholders, the potential changes in agency operations learned during the course can have a game-changing effect on agency E&O exposure. Swiss Re claims data reveals that no matter the size, business mix or geographic region, agencies that attend the seminar have better claims experience.
